Liz Graves of Spring Valley, MN has nearly 30 years of experience in the horse industry, is licensed to judge in the United States and Canada, and today spends most of her time conducting clinics nationwide – more than 200 all-breed gaited horse clinics since 1990.

She specializes in biomechanics, teaching positive choices and applications when using supportive aids, and addressing gait analysis and development. Her clinics are viewed as fun and informative to all riders.

Since 1990, Graves has judged more than 100 gaited and non-gaited horse shows, surveying more than 20,000 entrants.

On the competitive side, Graves has shown various gaited horses since 1978, garnering local, state, regional and national championships in a variety of breeds and disciplines.

In this clinic, she can work with Fox Trotters, Icelandics, Paso Finos,

Graves also owns Elizabeth Graves Productions, a video production firm producing videos such as "A Gathering of Gaits," "Icelandic Horse Gathering," "How Structure Relates to Gait," and her newest release, "A Bit About Bits."

**Illinois Horse Fair, presented by Purina Mills, Midway Trailer Sales and John Deere, is in its 21st year and annually attracts more than 10,000 horse people.**

**Clinic Fee:** \$200

Clinic fee covers 2 two-hour sessions: Saturday – identifying the horse's preferred gait; Sunday – helping horse and rider achieve their desired smooth gait. Horse must be well under saddle and manageable by its rider. No green-broke horses will be accepted.

Clinic fee includes one stall with first bedding, shared use of a tack stall, one exhibitor badge for rider and one weekend pass to Horse Fair. Clinic horses will be stalled together.

Clinic sessions may be audited by Horse Fair pass holders (general admission: \$12 per day; \$20 weekend).

Graves also will hold a one-hour Question & Answer session Sunday for clinic riders and observers.

All horses must have a current negative Coggins. Out-of-state horses must have Health Certificate and Entry Permit number. Signed release forms are required from all participants.
